The Italian Ice Sports federation (FISG) and the Ice Club Merano are honored to welcome you to the 20th Merano Cup.

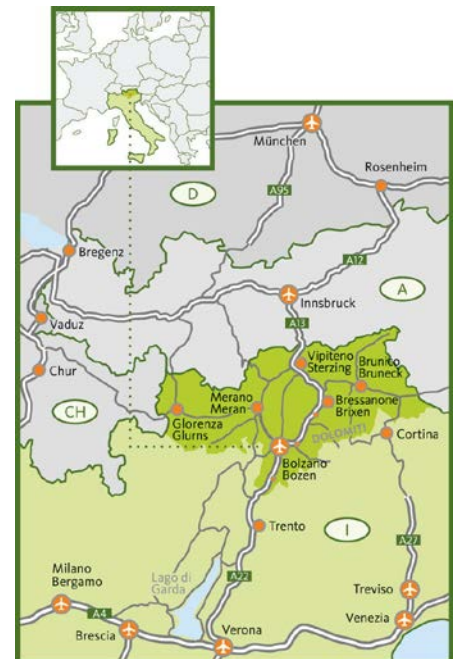
Geographical position

Merano is located in the north Italian Alps close to the Austrian and Swiss border. The Dolomites, world's most famous skiing and climbing area, are just round the corner and the capital city of the self-governed province South Tyrol, Bolzano-Bozen, is only at a 25 km distance.

Such well known cities like Innsbruck (Austria) and Verona (Italy) could be reached in approximately two hours by car.

The countryside of the Merano area is blessed, in a most particular way, with all the marvellous contrasts which this part of the world is known for:

the valleys meander at an altitude of a mere three hundred meters above sea-level backed by mountain peaks of over three thousand meters. Glaciers and rocky outcrops shaped by whirling snow storms tower above a sub-tropical garden paradise: an entire continent seems to be concentrated in this small corner of land: Scandinavia and the Riviera, wide ice fields shadowing a perfumed flower garden. These include the fascinating combination of South Tyrolean traditions and Mediterranean flair.



Travelling information

Merano lies within the heart of the Alps in South Tyrol in Italy. Although its peaceful, unique and beautiful position in the alps, Merano is easily and fast accessible. The next bigger city nearby is Bolzano/Bozen, which is the capital of South Tyrol and an important traffic junction. The distance to Bolzano/Bozen, is only 28km:

The official icerink “Meranarena”

The *Meranarena* ice-rink is one of the most beautiful multi-purpose ice-sports and event facilities in the Southern Alps region offering available capacity for 3.000 spectators. The modern architectural structure located straight to the famous *Merano horse racing circuit* matches perfectly to the environment and meets all requirements for athletes and public.

The ice-rink surface is 30 by 60 meters, the stadium is heated in the winter season and air-conditioned in the summer months.

Even though the *Meranarena* is situated at the town periphery, it is only a ten to fifteen minutes walk to the city centre and the old town, which offers many opportunities for shopping, sightseeing and amusement.

Sightseeing

Meran is well worth visiting for its historic sights alone. There are castles, churches, museums and quaint corners waiting to be discovered. Highlights include the charming Art Nouveau Kurhaus and theatre, and the gardens of Trauttmansdorff, with the castle where Sissi stayed.

Shopping

Meran's town centre is a veritable paradise for everyone who loves shopping. There are exclusive boutiques, trendy jeans outlets, branches of the most famous fashion chains, gourmet shops, bookshops and jewellers. There is nothing you will not find here. Just come and see!

Climate

The sub-mediterranean climate on the south side of the Alps ensures beautiful summers, clear autumn days and mild winters. During the autumn the weather conditions in Merano are usually rather stable and many sunny days are foreseen. The temperatures shift between 15°C in the night and 20-25°C during the day.
